

DOCTOR OF NURSING PRACTICE: POST-MASTER'S

Doctor of Nursing Practice: Post-Master's

St. Kate's post-master's DNP program is designed to meet the needs and demands of working adults. Completed within 21 months, this 36 credit program is based on best practices for online learning, combining synchronous and asynchronous learning with high faculty engagement. Students visit campus twice during the program at the beginning and end and follow the same cohort of students throughout the entire program.

Practicum experiences are structured in such a way that applied learning is enhanced and students have an opportunity to expand understanding of ethical leadership, social justice, interprofessional collaboration, knowledge of the discipline of nursing, informatics, evidence-based practice, organizational systems, healthcare economics and health policy. A final quality improvement project is required in order to demonstrate program outcomes and focuses on a specific practice issue identified by the student and supported by a DNP Project Team.

Degree Requirements

A minimum of 36 credits. The overall minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale is required. To complete your DNP, you will document the completion of 540 practicum/clinical hours.

Years to Complete the Program

Students are expected to complete the DNP Program within four years of initial enrollment and will be allowed to re-sequence only once in the DNP course of study.
