A student with a documented disability that impacts completion of a mathematics or logical reasoning course to satisfy the mathematics or logical reasoning liberal arts core requirement may petition for a course substitution.

To qualify, the student must meet with an access consultant in the Accessibility and Accommodations Department. The access consultant will:

- Review the student's documentation of a disability
- If appropriate, make a recommendation for a course substitution
- Write a letter of support for a course substitution

The director of academic advising will determine the substitute course(s) the student will take to complete the core requirement.
